To Whom It May Concern:

The Breastfeeding Management Clinic is held two mornings per week in the metro area and by appointment only. It is staffed by Pediatrician Maya Bunik, MD, FABM and Lorry Watkins, BSN, RN, IBCLC both with breastfeeding expertise and credentials.

Please check the appropriate boxes to complete the referral to this clinic:

- 1) Neonatal Intensive Care Unit infant after discharge
- 2) Mom's with multiple infants
- 3) Late preterm infant 35-38 weeks gestational age
- 4) Mom with abnormal breast anatomy or injuries to nipples
- 5) Refusal of breast/Poor latch and or painful breastfeeding
- 6) Low breastmilk production
- 7) Breastfeeding delay due to medical complications in the mother (e.g. post partum hemorrhage, retained placental fragment, HELLP) or in the infant (e.g. sepsis, hypoxic events, hyperbilirubinemia)
- 8) Breastfed infant with GERD
- 9) Breastfed infant with bloody stools and possible food sensitivity
- 10) Failure to thrive in the breastfed infant
- 11) Other
